Adopting from Foster Care

Children that have been removed from their family's care due to abuse or neglect are placed into the child welfare system, i.e. foster care. If their family is unable to remediate the circumstances surrounding the abuse or neglect, parental rights are terminated and the child becomes legally freed for adoption. These children remain in foster care until age 18 or a forever family is found.

At any time, there are hundreds of children across Florida awaiting adoption. In Brevard County, IMPOWER works in partnership with Brevard Family Partnership (BFP) to find these children the right family to provide their forever home.

Who are the children available for adoption?

- All races and ethnicities
- Most over the age of 10 years old
- Many are part of a sibling group
- They have experienced major losses and trauma
- Children with disabilities, medical needs or learning difficulties
- They will need behavioral and psychological support

How the Adoption Process Works

Who can adopt?

- Must be over the age of 21
- All individuals, couples or families with realistic hopes and expectations
- Health and energy to provide a long-term family for a child
- Willingness to recognize and embrace the importance of utilizing resources available pre and post-adoption

How much does it cost to adopt?

Typically, child welfare adoptions are completed with little to no cost to the adoptive family.

How long does it take to be ready to adopt?

The answer varies, but the process can usually be completed in 6-8 months.

Start Your Journey

Are you ready to explore adoption?

Complete an Initial Adoption Inquiry Form on our website or attend a free 1 hour orientation. Both will offer a chance to talk with our experienced staff and provide an overview of the entire child welfare adoption process.

If we all agree to proceed after orientation, we'll guide you from start to finish of your adoption journey which will include:

- Completion of specialized training
- A thorough home study
- Background, employment and reference checks
- The chance to change a life - including yours!
