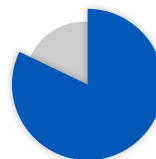

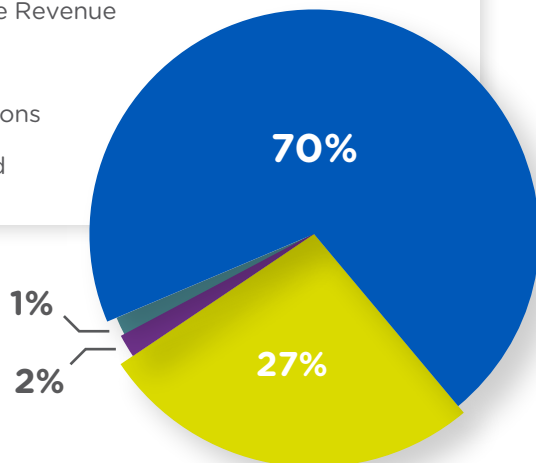

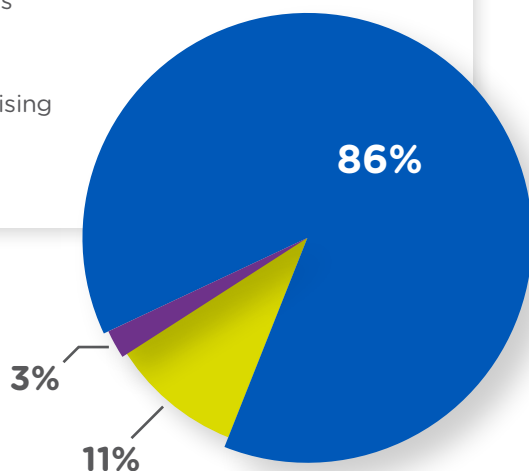

Inspiring a Path Forward

After a September 2023 arrest related to drug use and the removal of her children, a mother entered treatment for opioid and cocaine addiction for the first time. Through IMPOWER's telehealth services, she was able to access care and begin recovery. With ongoing support, she has maintained two years of sobriety, learned to better manage PTSD symptoms, and rebuilt stability in her life through full-time employment and independent housing. She has also earned her Peer Recovery Specialist certification and now uses her lived experience to support others in recovery.

Inspiring Success, One Youth at a Time

A young adult came to The Village after being suddenly kicked out of her adoptive home on her eighteenth birthday, losing both her sense of safety and the twin sister who had always been her anchor. With The Village's wraparound support, she steadily rebuilt her life by accessing critical resources, engaging in therapy, finding stable employment, and ultimately strengthening her bond with her sister. She is now working toward her associate's degree, has become a Registered Behavior Technician, and is stepping confidently into a future filled with hope and purpose that once felt out of reach.
